Southern Cross University Parking Rules for Staff & Students

Please note that Southern Cross University is a restricted parking area (RPA) as defined by section 60 of the Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Act 1999 and the Road Transport (General) Act 1999

Parking offenders shall be issued with an infringement notice which carries a fine which exceeds \$86 payable to the State Debt Recovery Office.

Parking rules are available for viewing at the Security Gatehouse, and the reception area of both the Office of the Executive Director of Corporate Services and Vice Chancellor. Parking rules are also displayed on the following web site: http://www.scu.edu.au/about/index.php/30/

Your attention is drawn to the following:

- 1) **No Student Parking on Campus** between the hours of **8am & 5pm**, **Mon-Fri.** On Campus being the areas within the Boom Gates.
- 2) You **MUST** park wholly within marked bays.
- 3) The following offences may result in an infringement notice being issued.
- a) Parking elsewhere other than a marked space
- b) Parking on lawns or gardens
- c) Parking in a disabled reserved space without authority
- d) Parking on footpaths
- e) Parking in any marked reserved space without authority
- f) Parking in Bus/Taxi bay
- g) Failing to display authorising permit
- h) Parking in a no parking area
- i) Visitor exceeding visitor space time limit
- j) Causing an obstruction
- k) Any vehicle parked in visitor defined space without a Visitor or Trade Permit
- 1) Parking in loading zones
- m) Parking on any roadway without authority
- n) Motorcycle parking space (unless motorcycle)
 - 4) There may be occasions for various reasons when you will be requested not to enter Campus or to relocate your vehicle
