English Language Proficiency program

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General English (GE)

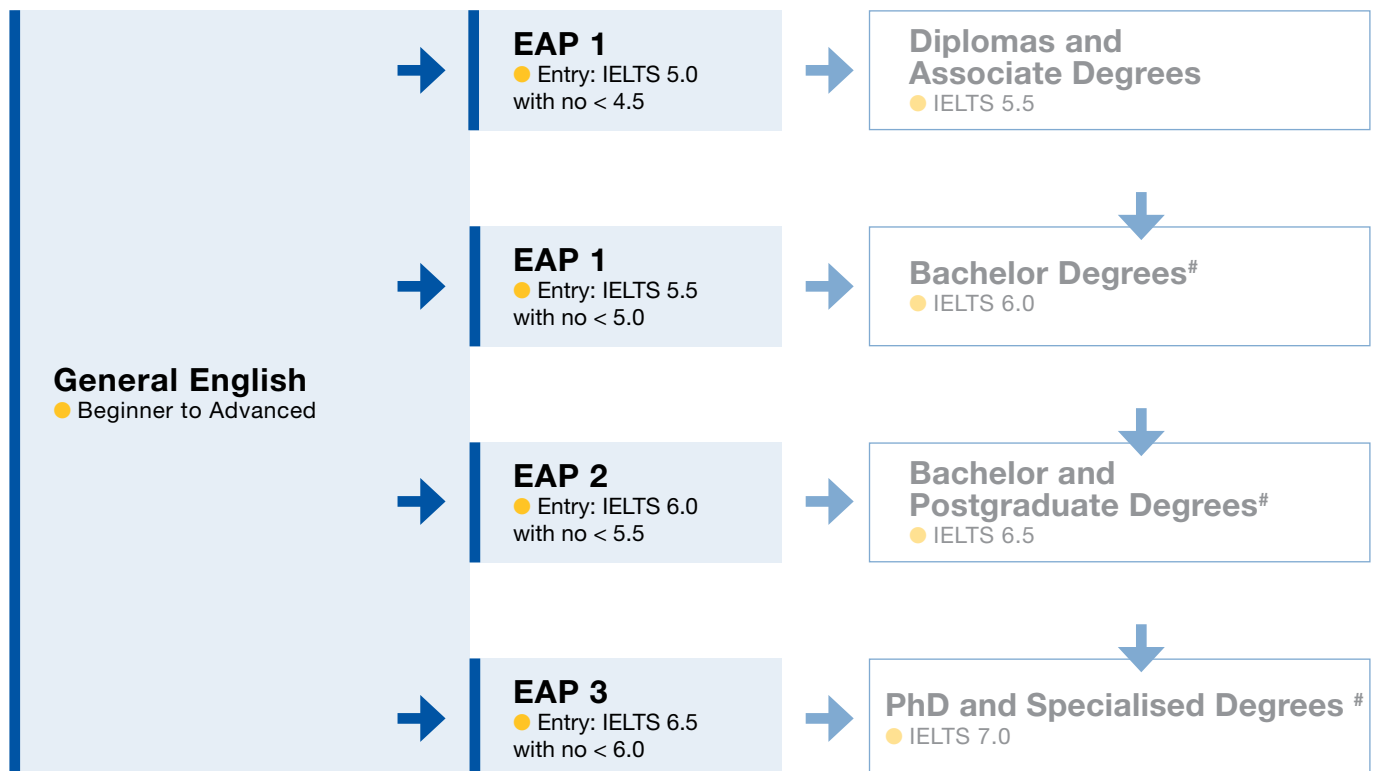
General English helps students develop their English speaking, listening, reading and writing skills with a focus on communicative English. Student have the opportunity to develop their language skills as well as strategies for learning and using English in a range of contexts (e.g. work, holidays).

English for Academic Purposes (EAP)

English for Academic Purposes prepares students for further studies at Southern Cross University at three entry levels. EAP develops students' academic skills for university including researching, referencing, using the Learning Management System and plagiarism detection software, note taking, group work and giving presentations. Successful completion of EAP provides direct entry to Southern Cross University.

Academic pathways

Undergraduate Qualifying Program (UQP)

This non-award pathway is designed as a preparation program for students who do not meet full academic and English language entry requirements into undergraduate degrees. The Undergraduate Qualifying Program develops the academic skills and English language proficiency required to undertake a Bachelor degree in business, tourism or information technology.

Advanced Standing

Successful completion of this course can provide up to two (2) units of advanced standing into the Bachelor of Business, Bachelor of Business Administration, Bachelor of Business in Tourism and Hospitality Management, Bachelor of Business in Convention and Event Management and Bachelor of Information Technology.

Postgraduate Qualifying Program (PQP)

This non-award pathway is designed as a preparation program for students who do not meet full academic and English language entry requirements into postgraduate degrees. The Postgraduate Qualifying Program develops the academic skills and English language proficiency required to undertake a Master degree in business or tourism.

Advanced Standing

Successful completion of this course can provide up to two (2) units of advanced standing into the Master of Business Administration (MBA), Master of Professional Accounting (MPA) and Master of International Tourism and Hotel Management (MITHM).

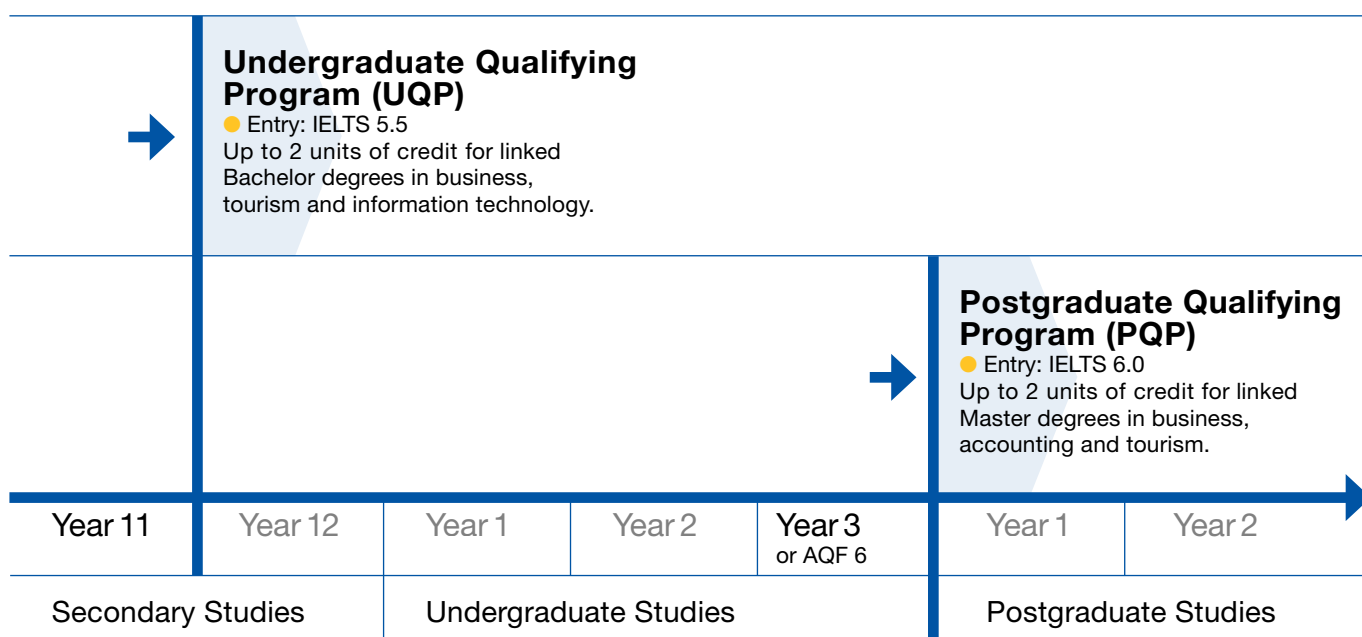

Diploma of Business

The Diploma of Business is a pathway into SCU business, tourism and information technology degrees. It includes a core of three SCU College units on language, learning and mathematics.

Successful completion of this course provides up to eight (8) units or one year of advanced standing into Bachelor degrees in business, information technology and tourism (see flowchart below).

Associate Degree of Business

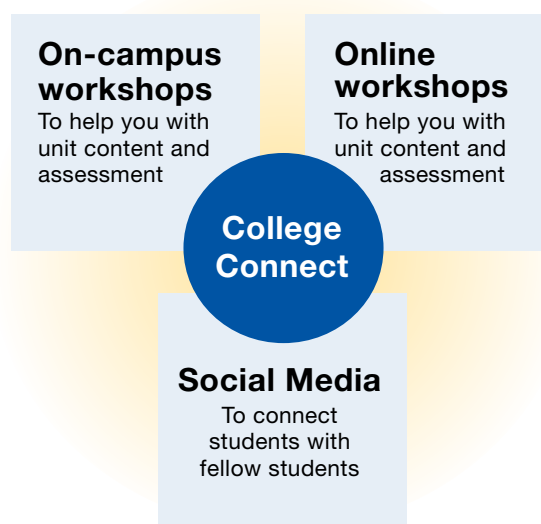
Diploma of Science

The Diploma of Science is a pathway into SCU environment, science and engineering degrees. It includes core studies in science that prepare students for further study through a range of units in science disciplines.

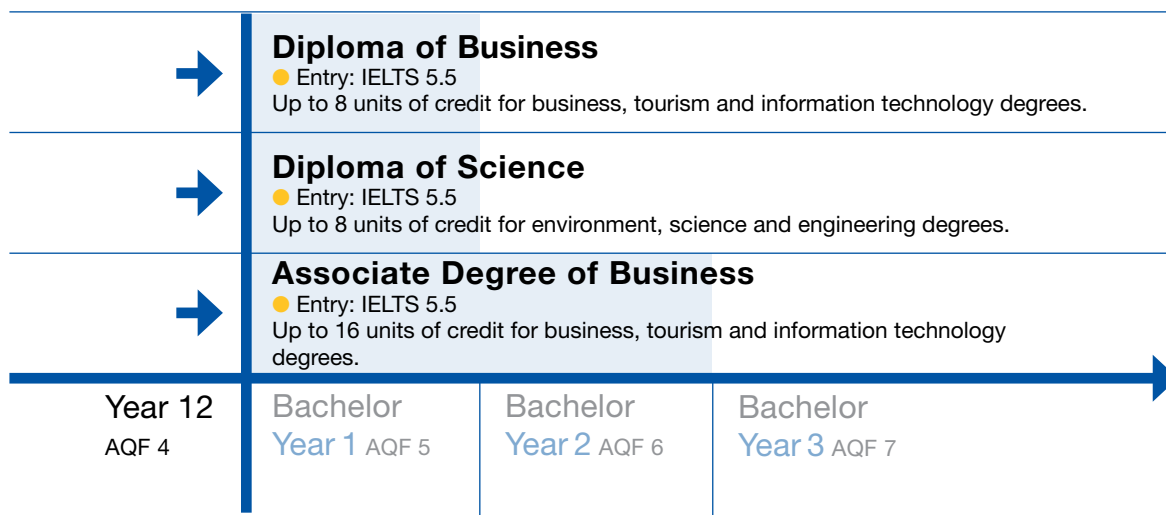
Advanced Standing

Career Start in Business (Study Abroad)

The Career Start in Business (Study Abroad) is designed for students wanting to broaden their international perspective in a location perfect to explore the best of Australia. Students gain credit for their studies with their home institution. The course starts with 10 or 20 weeks of the English Language Proficiency program and then four (4) units of academic study. Topics may include accounting, finance, economics, business, law, statistics, marketing, management, ethics and sustainability.

Advanced Standing

Successful completion of this course provides four (4) units of advanced standing into the Diploma of Business.

Career Start in Science (Study Abroad)

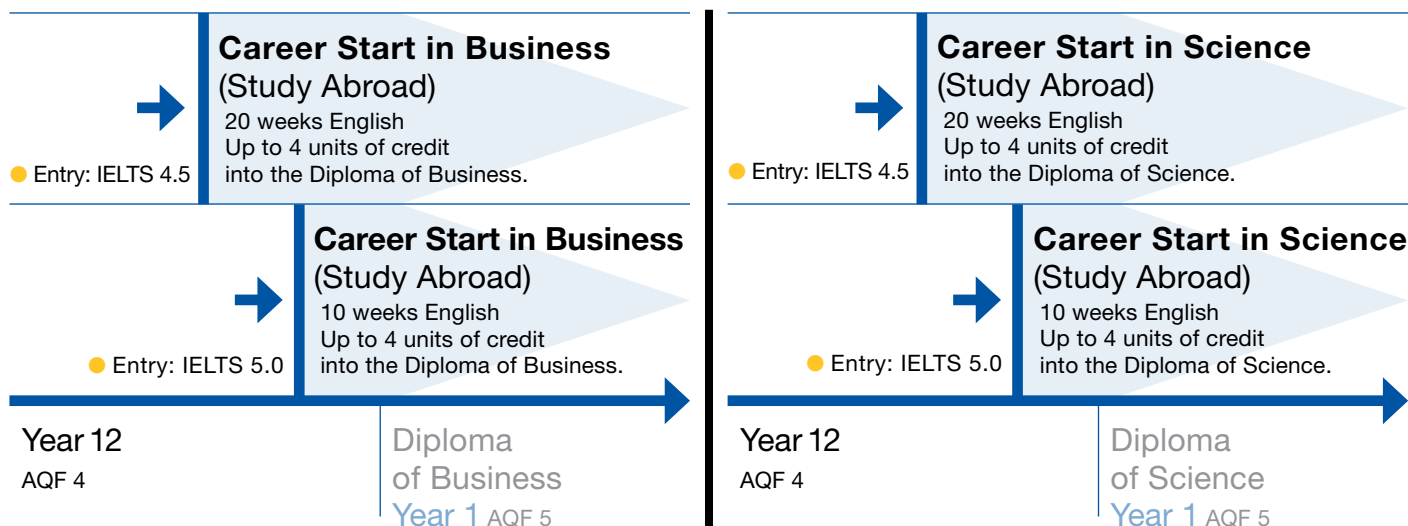
The Career Start in Science (Study Abroad) is designed for students wanting to broaden their international perspective in a location perfect to explore the best of Australia. Students gain credit for their studies with their home institution. The course starts with 10 or 20 weeks of the English Language Proficiency program and then four (4) units of academic study. Topics may include environmental science, marine science and management, forestry science and management and civil engineering.

Advanced Standing

Successful completion of this course provides four (4) units of advanced standing into the Diploma of Science.

Study tours

Study tours are offered at the Gold Coast, Lismore and Coffs Harbour campuses for students who want to learn English while experiencing a taste of life and study in Australia. These programs are available only to participants on visas other than a student visa. Programs can be designed for university level, professional, school-aged, and other groups as one, two, three, four and 10-week programs. Specialised programs can also be developed on request.

Study tours can include English classes, vocational lectures and relevant industry visits e.g. childcare, tourism, information technology, tropical horticulture, animal husbandry, aquaculture, organic growing, agribusiness, hairdressing, beautician program or marine science studies.
