Mr Walter Sofronoff QC was admitted to the Bar in 1977, became a Queen's Counsel in 1988 and was President of the Bar Association of Queensland between 1994 and 1996. He has appeared in the Queensland Supreme Court, Family Court, Federal Court and the High Court of Australia. He is a Fellow of the Australian Academy of Law and has been an Adjunct Professor of Law at the University of Queensland since 1999. Between 2005 and 2014 Mr Sofronoff QC was the Queensland Solicitor-General and also served as the President of the Queensland Anti-Discrimination Tribunal from 2001 to 2005.
