IMPORTANT PLEASE NOTE:

- 1. The NEW SONIA reports, it will commonly be referred to as being "Submitted". This terminology is used due to within these reports you have to press a SUBMIT button.
- 2. If your mentor does not have access to SONIA, its *IMPERATIVE*, you contact the team at <u>educationplacements@scu.edu.au</u> so access can be arranged or details passed on to your mentor.
- 3. Pre-service teachers DO NOT have access to write/edit a prac report ONLY your appointed mentor is given access

Mentors and Coordinators/Directors will use Sonia Online to access live placement reports for the student they are responsible for supervising for a placement period.
